A 65-lot auction of veteran printmaker and artist Lalitha Lajmi's prints that navigate the themes of death, performance, and complexities of human relationships. Lajmi's creative oeuvre even as she continues to paint in her Lokhandwala home at the age of 89 traverses over five



decades of etching and printmaking, pen and ink drawings, oil colour, and watercolour paintings.
